
FIP Rules of Procedure

BU-C11: FIP Presidential citation

Purpose of the Award

The purpose of the award is to recognise an individual who has shown inspirational, intensive and outstanding dedication and contribution in leading, developing and implementing a significant activity of FIP.

The citation is not presented every year, but only on occasions of unusual merit. It is therefore made on an *ad hoc* basis.

Nomination and Selection of Candidates

A candidate for the FIP Presidential Citation can be nominated by the President of FIP every year and the choice is then confirmed by the FIP Bureau.

Specific Eligibility Criteria

A person who is currently serving as a Bureau member of FIP is not eligible for the FIP Presidential Citation.

Award

The FIP President will present the FIP Presidential citation -a certificate of recognition - during the Opening Ceremony of an Annual FIP Congress or at another appropriate event organised by FIP.

The recipient of the award may nominate someone else to receive the certificate on his or her behalf. The recipient will not be expected to respond during the Presentation ceremony.

Other than in exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the Bureau, FIP will not provide any direct assistance to the recipient to be present at the award ceremony, e.g., travel or accommodation costs or congress/conference registration.
