- 1. How does EOL support to patients in the community differ from normal EOL situations?
- 2. What variety of medications are required to treat COVID-19 patients in EOL in a community setting?
 - a. Could a limited number of medications be used to cover the significant majority of patients in this cohort?
 - b. i.e. is the preparation of standard treatment packs a viable approach to cover 80% of patients?
- 3. Are oral medications appropriate for COVID-19 patients in their last few days?
 - a. Can they be effectively administered?
- 4. Have you resorted to non-injectable forms of medicinal support for COVID-19 end of life patients?
 - a. If so, what drove you to do so?
- 5. What length of time would it be normal to expect to need palliation for patients in the community?
- 6. Are there any top tips you would suggest for palliative care of end of life COVID-19 patients in the community?
- 7. With the benefit of hindsight is there anything you wish you would have done before or done differently?
- 8. Community Pharmacy How have you approached supporting community pharmacy staff to ensure their safety?
