The FIP Global Competency Framework identifies critical competencies needed for pharmacists and student pharmacists to deliver advanced pharmacy services. The development and implementation of innovative services at Schools of Pharmacy can serve as a mechanism to provide the educational and practice competencies needed to deliver patient care programs that improve patient outcomes and well-being of patients. Examples of innovative programs within a School of Pharmacy will highlight the opportunity to train pharmacists and student pharmacists with the competencies recommended in the framework. Practical take-home tips will be provided to develop patient care programs that advance practice and improve the health of communities while achieving economic outcomes.
