Abstract:

Uroš Čakar is from Belgrade, Serbia where he gained education from primary and high school. He graduated from the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Belgrade with the MSc pharmacy degree. During the studies he was secretary general of student's Pharmaceutical Research Society Dr Jovan Tucakov, and an active member of NAPSER-National Pharmaceutical Students Association. He was an active member of European Pharmaceutical Student's Association-EPISA where he held the position, EPISA Pharmaceutical Sciences Working Committee Director first from Serbia in 40 years of existence of EPISA. During the years in EPISA he was chairmen of many sessions and moderator of workshops. He is currently on PhD studies of bromatology, on Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Belgrade. His field of investigation are antioxidants from the natural products and food with particular interest on wine, fruit and their influence on human health. Beside it he also investigate the role of pharmacists in the patient counseling, as providers of new services in pharmacy, such as advices regarding health and balanced nutrition and good lifestyle habits. Also he is involved in the investigation of history of pharmacy in Serbia and other countries of the world. Uroš Čakar is author of many scientific papers in peer reviewed journals and abstracts on national and international congresses. He is also working with students on practical courses at graduate studies of Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Belgrade and he was a co-mentor of 10 master thesis. Uroš Čakar was appointed by the dean in the Committee for foundation of exhibition in History of Pharmacy museum at the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Belgrade. Beside it he is a member of national professional pharmaceutical organizations and FIP. On FIP world congress 2016 and 2017 organized in Buenos Aires, Argentina and Seoul, Republic of Korea he was a co-chairman of the session for history of pharmacy and invited speaker as well. He is also member of FIP Young Pharmacist Group. Beside it he made many articles regarding FIP, interviews with FIP executives and pharmacists around the world for the Serbian pharmaceutical journal Informator.
