



Aim and expected outcomes of the FIP-UNESCO UNITWIN Regional Workshops

The aim of these workshops is to bring academic leaders, professional organisations and key pharmacy stakeholders from your region together to co-create a roadmap to advance pharmacy and pharmaceutical sciences in your region through educational partnerships. The findings from the pre-work that will be completed by FIP’s member academic institutions and consequent regional workshops will provide countries and academic institutions with a solid strategy for prioritising their needs on pharmacy and pharmaceutical sciences education and addressing these through educational partnerships, aligned with the [FIP Development Goals](#). The regional workshops will conclude with a “Regional roadmap on pharmacy and pharmaceutical sciences education”.

FIP will consolidate regional roadmaps and publish a “Global call to action on pharmacy and pharmaceutical sciences education” at the FIP-UNITWIN Global Summit that will take place in December 2021. FIP will offer institutions participating in these workshops the opportunity to become a member of the [FIP-UNESCO UNITWIN regional network](#), in which institutions will be recognised as FIP-UNESCO chairs, and establish educational partnerships to advance pharmacy and pharmaceutical sciences education.

High-level workshop programme

A two-hour workshop:

1. Opening by regional chair – 5 mins
2. Video messages from FIP President and FIP CEO - 5 mins
3. Part 1: Discuss the FIP DGs mapping from primary health care perspective - 45 mins
4. Part 2: Validate regional SWOT and develop a regional roadmap – 1h
5. Closing by the regional chair -5 mins
