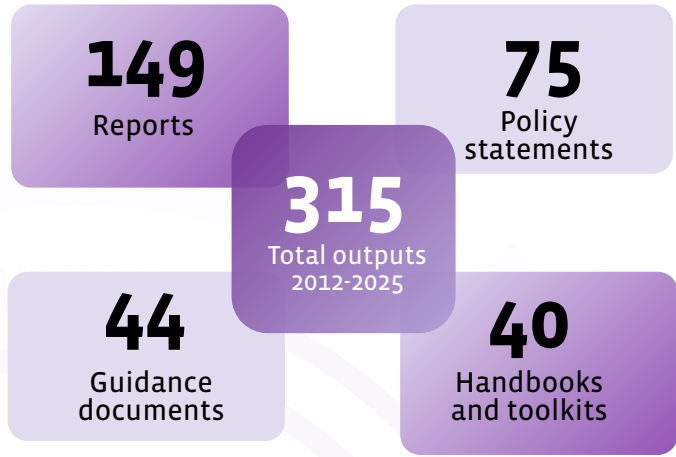


FROM EVIDENCE TO IMPACT

Since 2012, FIP has produced a wealth of outputs and publications that reflect its vision, mission, and values. From FIP's centenary in 2012 until the end of 2025, FIP has produced a total of 315 outputs, including reports, statements, guidance documents, handbooks, toolkits, and frameworks, produced across various FIP programmes.

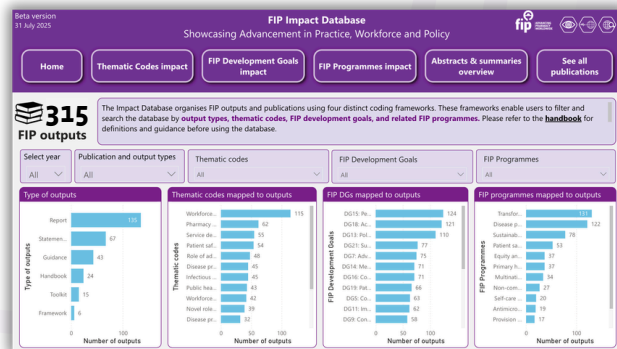


Reports, statements, and guidance documents constitute the majority of published FIP outputs, showing a steady growth trend over the past five years.

To provide structured access to this comprehensive range of outputs, FIP has developed a centralised platform that collates and categorises its outputs supporting pharmacy transformation worldwide.

What is the Impact Database?

The **FIP Impact Database** is a strategic tool that collates, summarises, categorises, and provides access to a complete range of outputs that support the Federation and its members' vision and mission.



Our goal: To build a global evidence base that empowers our members with data, insights, and evidence that support their roles and responsibilities in healthcare, facilitating pharmacy's development, innovation, and a greater impact on patient and public health outcomes.
